PHANTOM SKEET CLUB RANGE SAFETY BRIEF

It will be the responsibility of all Phantom Skeet Club members and their guests using the club's ranges to adhere with the following rules, procedures and practices. Failure to do so, could result in permanent expulsion from the range.

GENERAL RULES AND PAPERWORK

A trained Range Safety Officer (RSO) will open the range, be present for any shooting, and will close the range, all in accordance with separate RSO procedures. Only persons properly trained may open, operate, or close the range or its machines. The RSO shall be the focal point of range operations, and their commands will be followed by all present on the facility.

- 1. All persons within the confines of the facility will display a Guest or Membership Badge in a clearly visible manner on the front of their person to include the front of the hat. Possession of this badge certifies that the member or guest has read and agrees to bide by all range rules, and has signed a current Agreement and Release of Liability Form on file.
- 2. Only authorized club members and their occasional guest are authorized to use the club facilities. Guests must be accompanied by a member. Anyone observing a person without a guest or member club badge will immediately direct them to the on duty RSO.
- Firearms allowed: ONLY SHOTGUNS UTILIZING 7.5 LEAD SHOT OR SMALLER will be utilized on the ranges or patterning area. ABSOLUTELY NO STEEL, SLUGS OR ANY RIFLE/PISTOL SHOOTING WILL BE ALLOWED ON THIS FACILITY.
- 4. Fire at authorized targets only. Firing at cans, bottles, exploders etc. is strictly prohibited. Ensure that all projectiles impact designated areas and stay within the established range safety limits.
- 5. Member and guests must never walk in front of the low house windows when open and being operated to prevent injury in the accidental release of a target. No members are authorized to enter any High or Low House or to load clay throwers unless specifically authorized and trained in proper safety procedures.
- 6. No member, unless specifically authorized by a Club Officer will perform adjustment or maintenance of any Clay Target Thrower.
- 7. Archery practice is allowed where targets have been set up.
- 8. Guns will be made safe and firing positions vacated if any person executes the "CEASE FIRE" command for any reason.
- 9. Anyone observing a vehicle or person on Perimeter Road, approaching beyond the downrange area, or stopped at the flashing red lights waiting for clearance to cross, or actually crossing, shall immediately shout the command "CEASE FIRE" and ensure RSO and shooters are aware. Shooting will not resume until RSO gives the ALL CLEAR.
- 10. Any club member or guest observing an unsafe act or condition involving firearms, bows or range operations, is required as a condition of range use and membership to immediately bring the condition to the attention of all present and cease all range activities. Upon correction of the unsafe activity, and approval of the RSO, range operations may proceed.
- 11. Spectators, other than designated coaches will not enter the Skeet Range while shooting is being conducted.
- 12. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited on the club property. No person shall be permitted on these ranges when impaired or otherwise under the influence of alcohol or any other substance.
- 13. Horseplay of any sort is prohibited. Any person violating this rule, after receiving one verbal warning, shall be subject to ejection from the range property.

- 14. Eye and hearing protection will be worn while on the range or sitting in covered gazebos or closer and shooting operations are occurring.
- 15. Shotguns must be unloaded and actions open at all times except when standing on the shooting station ready to shoot. Over/Under and side-by-side shotguns can be stored unloaded with actions closed, only when placed in a gun rack. Once removed from the gun rack, their actions must be opened immediately.
- 16. Shotgun breech shall remain open upon entering and departing range shooting positions. They will remain open until the shooter takes a shooting position upon his/her turn to shoot.
- 17. Ammunition will only be loaded into any gun when the shooter is correctly positioned in a firing position. No more than two shells will be loaded at one time.
- 18. When occupying firing positions, shooters will keep their shotguns pointed safely down range. Shotguns shall be safely pointed towards the ground or skyward when waiting to shoot or passing behind other shooters upon changing of stations.
- 19. No person shall attempt to retrieve expended shotgun cases (hulls) until all shooting has ceased and the range and firing lines have been cleared. It is the responsibility of each shooter to police their own expended hulls.
- 20. Basic gun safety rules will be followed, including:
 - a. ALWAYS keep the gun pointed in a safe direction—even if you are certain, it is unloaded
 - b. ALWAYS keep your finger off of the trigger until ready to shoot.
 - c. ALWAYS keep the gun unloaded until it is ready to be used.
 - d. Don't rely on your gun's "SAFETY"—ALWAYS assume a gun could fire by mistake.
 - e. Be sure of your target and what is beyond it.
 - f. Use correct ammunition, and inspect each round before you put it in your firearm.
 - g. If your gun fails to fire when the trigger is pulled. HANDLE WITH CARE! KEEP IT POINTED IN A SAFE DIRECTION until the malfunction is cleared.
 - h. Be sure barrel is clear of obstructions before shooting. Be alert for signs of ammunition malfunction, and "off" sound or "light recoil" when it is fired. Do not load another round in the chamber until you are sure the barrel and chamber are clear.
 - i. Be familiar with how your gun functions. If you are not certain of how to unload, load and safely operated it, ask for instruction prior to attempted use.
 - j. Wherever you handle any firearm, or hand it to someone, always open the action and visually check the chamber to ensure it is completely unloaded.
 - k. Always wear eye and ear protection.
